Please be advised that the Final Brief of Appellant contains errors in the **Statement of Facts** found on page 4 and under section 3, titled **The Nuetral Principles analysis does not require that a trust be expressly mentioned in a deed.**

Under the heading **Statement of Facts** there are two (2) incorrect statements. (1) The second sentence which reads "simultaneously a second notice was give by correspondence dated May 11, 2011 informing the duly appointed pastor that her services were terminated" is incorrect. Also, (2) the fourth sentence is incorrect which reads "Defendants later issued a Declaration and Resolution To Secede and withdraw permanently from the AME Church General Conference.


