I, Ryan Powell, am the pro se Appellant in the above specified appeal case.

Pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, I respectfully request a 15-day extension of time in which to file my Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal, which are presently due to be filed by December 28th. With the requested extension granted the due date will become January 12, 2023. I thought I would be able to meet the present filing deadline early (i.e., before the holidays) but I was unable to do that because of my heavy year-end workload at my job.
