Dear Mr. Davis:

This Court has today received a document from you entitled "Brief of Appellant." As indicated in this Court's order and letter of June 6, 2013, you are now representing yourself in this matter. You will need to serve and file a petition for a writ of certiorari and appendix within thirty (30) days of the day on which you receive the transcript and other documents from the Division of Appellate Defense. I remind you that the petition and appendix must comply with the requirements set forth in Rule 243 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). A copy of the SCACR should be available to you in your prison library.

Since your "Brief of Appellant" does not comply with the requirements of a petition under Rule 243, no action will be taken on it.

Finally, this Court has also received a letter from you dated June 5, 2013. In this letter, you suggest that this matter should be remanded to the circuit court. Since you have not provided a proof of service showing that a copy of this letter has been served on opposing counsel, no action will be taken on it.

Please remember that any documents that you send to this Court must be accompanied by proof of service showing that a copy has been served on the opposing counsel. Further, if your desire to seek a remand, you will need to serve and file a motion that complies with the requirements of Rule 240, SCACR.
