**Re: Persistent Issues of whatever I manage to get to your courts NOT appearing on the public record.
(PLEASE specifically file in SC Appellate Cases 2021-000815 and 2022-000339)**

Your Honors:

Though I am *in effect* sentenced to permanent misery in SC Appellate Case 2021-000815, I was NOT sentenced to my submissions NOT showing up on C-Track in SC Appellate Case 2022-000339, which is "a criminal matter in which [I am] not represented by counsel," and thus one of the exceptions to my sentence in SC Appellate Case 2021-000815. Both your courts gave "required" a broad meaning to include whatever is reasonably necessary for me to, God willing, prevail *pro se* in such criminal cases.


On 28 December 2022, I hand-filed and hand-served my revised initial brief and three related motions in 2022-000339. These *still* do NOT appear on C-Track even though a submission by *pro se* criminal appellant Bobby Joe Fulton, Jr. was docketed on 28 December 2022 and a response to it went out on 29 December 2022, which indicates that court personnel were on the job and equipped at that time.

Otherwise, in her 13 December 2022 letter to me, Ms. Howard asks me to "understand" that her Court is worried about its safety from disabled litigants parking in its newly-"beautified" parking lot. *If*, for example, I (like Richland County's Bar's president) had led a group of *pro se* litigants to offer a solar panel on SC Supreme Court's building and/or modernize its oral argument room's ventilation as a "beautification" gift to the Court, I would have been dragged through more criminal proceedings.

Nor do I "understand" how the Court needs to enclose itself behind a brick-walled parking lot yet takes itself on the road before large groups of immature students. But in August 2010, then-assistant-solicitor Sara Heather Savitz Weiss moved to hold *me* too mentally-incompetent to proceed *pro se*. Suffice it to record that Ms. Weiss' motion was denied and Justice Few complimented my intellect. Not stupidity, but resentment of hypocrisy, leaves me unable to "understand" glaring inconsistencies.

Nonetheless, I ask Ms. Kitchings to check why my 28 December 2022 submission are still not uploaded to my case; and I ask Ms. Howard to confirm that, under any calculation, I have by now fully served both the active ten days and the suspended 170 days of my six-month sentence. Any part of the sentence which is in effect for longer than six months is not permitted as I was not tried by a jury.


