
3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay.

4. On December 28, 2022, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by


Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through January 31, 2023.
