## ORDER

---

Appellant's motion to allow late filing of his reply to Respondents' return to his motion to supplement the record on appeal is granted and Appellant's reply is accepted as filed. However, after careful consideration, Appellant's motion to supplement the record is denied. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record shall not . . . include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal.").

Appellant's motion to order Respondents to provide "requested information to which [] Appellant is lawfully entitled" is denied.

Finally, Appellant's amended record on appeal, filed August 31, 2022, still contains three matters which were not designated by any party for inclusion in the record, and which were stricken by this court's July 20, 2022 order. Accordingly, within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall file a second amended record on appeal, which complies with this court's July 20, 2022 order and the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Failure to comply may result in dismissal of this appeal.
