


ORDER

On July 20, 2022, the court of appeals affirmed the order of the circuit court requiring Petitioner to register as a sex offender. *State v. Fraley*, 437 S.C. 135, 876 S.E.2d 703 (Ct. App. 2022). Petitioner's petition for rehearing was denied on August 12, 2022. Petitioner failed to timely file a petition for a writ of certiorari with this Court, and the court of appeals sent the remittitur on September 19, 2022. Petitioner subsequently filed his petition for a writ of certiorari and a motion for an extension of time with this Court on October 18, 2022. We dismiss the petition for a writ of certiorari and deny the motion for an extension of time. *See Wise v. S.C. Dep't of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 174, 642 S.E.2d 551, 551 (2007) (holding when the remittitur has been properly sent, the appellate court no longer has jurisdiction).
