

On July 24, 2019, a jury convicted the Defendant, who was tried in his absence, of three counts of Second Degree Burglary (Violent). He was sentenced to twelve years on each indictment, with the sentences to run concurrent.

After his conviction, the Defendant filed a Motion for a Mistrial. This Court heard and granted the Defendant's motion on April 16, 2021. As the Defendant's motion was granted, his sentences are vacated. It is therefore ordered that the Defendant be released from the custody of the South Carolina Department of Corrections. The Defendant shall be transported to the J. Reuben Long Detention Center in Horry County, South Carolina, and

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the State of South Carolina, will move before the Court of General Sessions, on such date and time as the Court may provide, for reconsideration of the Court's grant of Defendant's Motion for a Mistrial.

Defendant Theodore Jerry Bolick was tried and convicted for three charges of Burglary, 2nd Degree (Violent) in his absence in July 2019. The Court sealed his sentence and issued a bench warrant for his arrest. He was arrested in North Carolina on his Bench Warrant and brought back to Horry County for the unsealing and imposition of his sentence. His sentence was unsealed and Defendant subsequently filed, amongst other things, a Motion for Mistrial. This Motion was heard by the Honorable R. Ferrell Cothran, Jr. who granted Defendant's motion.

The State moves this Court, specifically Judge Cothran, to reconsider his grant of Defendant's Motion for a Mistrial. The State can and will demonstrate good cause as grounds for this motion.
