ORDER

This court dismissed this appeal on September 7, 2022, after Appellant failed to serve the record on appeal. The remittitur was sent on October 3, 2022. Respondents have filed a motion for costs, pursuant to Rule 222, SCACR, seeking to recover \$2,500 in attorney's fees. Appellant did not file a return.

We grant the motion in part. *See* Rule 222, SCACR (providing costs shall be taxed against the appellant when the appeal is dismissed and costs may include attorney's fees *up to* \$2,500). Respondents are awarded \$1,500 in attorney's fees. The Beaufort County Clerk of Court is directed to add this award to the remittitur.
