This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Shannon Lane Bone respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time.

Counsel filed the second petition for rehearing in the case of Adonis Williams v. The State with the Court of Appeals on November 28, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Shiquan Tyon Cwiklinski v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 22, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Bryan Roeker v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 15, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Alexander Rhue, Jr. with Court of Appeals on November 14, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Derek Maner v. The State with the Court of Appeals on November 2, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of Adonis Williams v. The State with the Court of Appeals on October 27, 2022. Counsel filed the return to State's petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Michael N. Frasier with the Supreme Court on October 26, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Lance Antonio Brewton with the Supreme Court on October 24, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


