The affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

On 12/28/2018 at approx. 2344hrs, a victim contacted the Myrtle Beach Police Department to report an armed robbery that occurred on this same date at approx. 2200hrs while in the area of 67th Ave N. and Bryant St, which is located within the City limits of Myrtle Beach. Officers responded to 3200 S. Ocean Blvd to speak to the victim about the incident. Further investigation revealed the victim was driving on Bryant St from 67th Ave N. at a slow rate of speed when two unknown suspects approached the vehicle. Victim was sitting on the driver's seat when the first taller suspect, later identified as the defendant, pulled open the passenger side door and leaned inside the vehicle while holding a black handgun pointing towards the right side of the victim's head. The second suspect, later identified as the co-defendant, approached the driver's side window and pointing a black handgun towards the left side of the victim's head while at the same time demanding money from the victim. Victim gave the Co-defendant a wallet containing credit cards and approx. \$80 in cash while the first suspect, Defendant, took away the victim's iPhone from the center console. Victim drove away after the robbery and later arrived at a hotel to report the incident to the police.

On 12/30/2018, the defendant was arrested for another Armed Robbery incident where the Defendant used a social media app called Grinder to lure another victim on 12/27/2018 at a nearby apartment complex called Sea Path located on 67th Ave N, which is also within the city limits of Myrtle Beach. In a post Miranda interview, the defendant admitted to using the Grinder app to communicate to three different people in the past three days and all three people have been identified as victims of armed robbery in the city including this victim on 12/28/18. Defendant placed himself in the area and time of the armed robbery reported by the victim. Furthermore, the Defendant positively identified the Grinder photo as himself when presented with the same photo that a victim had provided as the suspect to law enforcement on 12/27/2018.

Based upon the stated facts, that the defendant did participate in concert with a co-defendant in a robbery with a deadly weapon, there is probable cause to believe the defendant did commit the offense of Armed Robbery, 16-11-330.

The affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

On 12/29/2018 officers of the Myrtle Beach Police Department opened an investigation into an Armed Robbery that occurred on this date in the area of 6509 Bryant St. which is located within the city limits of Myrtle Beach. The victim used a social media app called Grindr to meet with the Defendant at the incident location. When the victim arrived at the location he was approached by the Defendant and a Co-Defendant who pointed what appeared to be handguns at him while demanding that he surrender his personal property. The victim was shown a photograph from the Grindr profile of the Defendant and did identify it as the same photograph that he saw on the app. A SLED Facial recognition indicated the Grindr photo as a possible match for the Defendant and a SC DMV photo confirmed the Defendant's identity.

On 12/30/2018, the Defendant was arrested for another Armed Robbery incident where he used the social media app called Grindr to lure another victim on 12/27/2018 at a nearby apartment complex called Sea Path located on 67th Ave N, which is also within the city limits of Myrtle Beach. In a post Miranda interview, the Defendant admitted to using the Grindr app to communicate to three different people in the past three days and all three people have been identified as victims of Armed Robberies in the City of Myrtle Beach including this victim on 12/29/18. The Defendant placed himself and the Co-Defendant in the area and time of the Armed Robbery reported by the victim and admitted to knowing that the Armed Robbery took place. Furthermore, the Defendant identified the Grindr photo as himself when presented with the same photo that the victim viewed on the app.

Based upon the stated facts, that the Defendant did participate in a robbery with what appeared to be a deadly weapon, there is probable cause to believe the Defendant did commit the offense of Armed Robbery, 16-11-330.





 - (b) All tangible objects obtained from the State's witnesses in this case;
 - (c) All tangible objects the State intends to introduce into evidence at Trial which are relevant to the offense charged.
4. Make available any witnesses known to the State who have knowledge of facts which might be favorable to the Defendant.
5. Make available any promises made or actions taken by the State which caused or might have caused any witnesses for the State to testify on behalf of the State.
6. Make available any inconsistent statements made by witnesses for the State or any statements made by witnesses for the State which tend to exculpate the Defendants or to negate participation by the Defendants in the alleged crime.


