2. Counsel will file the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Robert Hollis v. State with the Supreme Court on January 20, 2023. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Jerry Davis v. State with the Supreme Court on January 12, 2023. Counsel


filed the initial brief of appellant in the case of State v Samuel McNeil with the Court of Appeals on January 6, 2023. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v Melvin James White with the Supreme Court on December 29, 2023. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Christopher A. Wylie v. State with the Supreme Court on December 15, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Xzariera Gray with the Court of Appeals on December 8, 2022

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




