Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$250.00.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Opposing counsel and the clerk of the lower court must be served a copy of the notice of appeal.
- An amended notice of appeal that is substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR must be served and filed.
- A request to stay the proceedings in the lower court was mentioned in your notice of appeal. A motion to stay, a proof of service accompanying the motion, and a motion fee of \$50.00 must be filed in order for the Court to act.
