MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI AND
ACCOMPANYING APPENDIX

Counsel for Randy Robinson respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Randy Robinson respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Robert Bailey with the Court of Appeals on January 18, 2023. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Jonathan Duncan with the Supreme Court on December 9, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Jeffery Truesdale with the Court of Appeals on December 8, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Austin McQuarters v. The State with the Supreme Court on December 5, 2022. Counsel filed the second petition for rehearing in the case of Adonis Williams v. The State with the Court of Appeals on November 28, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Shiquan Tyon Cwiklinski v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 22, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Bryan Roeker v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 15, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Alexander Rhue, Jr. with Court of Appeals on November 14, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


