Dear Mr. Jeter:

In response to your inmate request forms dated September 11 and 13, 2010, please be advised that I see no reason to remove Ms Price as your attorney. I also do not believe a conflict of interest exists which would disqualify Ms Price or any other attorney in this office. I believe that your request forms contain several incorrect statements which I also need to address.

As I understand your forms, you believe that a bench warrant was issued for your arrest because you did not attend a "roll call"; however, the bench warrant was actually issued because you failed to attend a hearing on June 23, 2010, when the State moved to revoke your bond. Prior to the hearing Ms Price attempted to contact you, but you had not provided her or this office with an updated address or telephone number. Furthermore, Ms Price did not tell you that she would attend "all your roll calls" and that you did not need to attend them. At most, Ms Price would have advised you that you did not need to attend the "second appearance," but neither Ms Price nor any of the other attorneys would have told you not to attend docket call or "roll call."

X You also claim that you should have another attorney because you believe that one of my assistant public defenders, James Cheek, is associated with the Spartanburg Community Memorial Committee, which is a victim in some of the forgery cases against you. (I do not know if Mr. Cheek is indeed associated with that committee, but even if he is, Mr. Cheek is not a witness in this matter) and will not be called to testify at your trial. I also understand that Mr. Cheek does not have any direct information which can or will be used against you in connection with these charges. I do not believe that this constitutes a conflict which would disqualify Ms Price or any other attorney in my office from serving as your attorney. (Ms Price will insure that no confidential information about your involvement, if any, is given to Mr. Cheek) and Ms Price also retains full authority over the objectives of your representation so that she will not be influenced in any manner by Mr. Cheek.

Lastly, you stated that Ms Price has not provided you a copy of your discovery. Ms Price has shown me a copy of a cover letter demonstrating that she provided you a copy of your



1) Prosecutorial Misconduct

At trial the prosecutor deliberately misrepresented the facts and evidence before the courts, in an attempt to deny Applicant a fair opportunity to present his case before the courts. See transcript pg # 16, Lines 10, 13. Clearly there can be no dispute that these indictments in question were less than \$5,000.

Finding of facts and Conclusions of Law

Clearly there can be no dispute that said misconduct "perjury" by said prosecutor was prejudicial to the effective and expeditious administration of the business of the courts. Said actions are in clear violation of SCACR Rule 402, and said Allegations should be considered in this court decision. Rules of Professional Conduct, Rule 8.3 Candor towards the tribunal, states upon ascertaining that material evidence is false a lawyer shall seek to persuade "party offering such" that the evidence should not be offered, or if has been offered, that its false character should be immediately disclosed, the lawyer must take reasonable remedial measure. See Rule 3.4. Fairness to opposing party and counsel, states documents and other items of evidence are often essential to establish a claim or defense, and the exercise of that Right ^{can} ~~cannot~~ be frustrated if relevant material is altered, concealed or destroyed.

Further, falsifying evidence is also generally a criminal offense. See Rule 3.5. Impartiality and decorum of the tribunal, states, a lawyer should present the case, protect the record for subsequent review and preserve professional integrity. See Rule 4.1. Truthfulness in statements to others, states, a lawyer is "required" to be "truthful" when dealing with others, misrepresentation can also occur by a failure to act. Further, an attorney has an obligation not only in professional ethics but under law as well to, avoid implications in the commission of perjury or other falsification of evidence. See SCACR Rule 413, Rule (2) Terminology (E) Misconduct: any conduct by a lawyer constituting grounds for discipline, See Rule 7, 1-8, and (2) Serious Crimes: any felony or lesser crime that reflects adversely on a lawyer's honesty, trustworthiness, or involves the interference with the administration of justice, ie, false swearing, misrepresentation, fraud or deceit. See State v Kindberg, 438 S.E. 2d 116 (CA App 1993), Perjury - a person commits offense of false swearing generally when he, having either taken oath or affirmation or executed documents knowing that it purports to be acknowledgment of lawful oath or affirmation, knowingly and willfully makes false statements. See Statute 18 U.S.C.A § 1621 Perjury.

2) Involuntary and Unknowing Plea

Additionally, the applicant is alleging that his guilty plea was not a knowing and intelligent decision among the wide range of choices available to him. Specifically, the applicant was never informed on the record or of the record that said charges would be ran concurrent. In fact applicant

was informed by counsel as the record will clearly reflect that his plea recommendation was for five counts of larceny and two counts of petty larceny to run concurrently with each other and with his probation violation, additionally he valid plea to one count of obtaining goods by false pretenses, and two counts of receiving stolen goods with a recommendation of a consecutive term of ten years suspended to five years of probation with restitution. The remaining three charges will be dismissed. See transcript pg # 17, Lines 1-14., See transcript pg # 17, 18 Lines 20-25, Lines 1-18

Clearly there can be no dispute that such a recommendation existed, was stated on record and informed to applicant. Clearly there can be no dispute that said plea recommendation was complex and was arranged in three stages. Clearly there can be no dispute that said plea was for a max of a ~~10~~⁵ year sentence.

Further, the record clearly reflects that the applicant was never informed by counsel on or off the record that the state would be seeking sentencing enhancements. None does the record reflect that the applicant was afforded his procedural due process right of a hearing for said enhancements. Clearly the record reflects that these offenses were a continuous chain of one event. See transcript pg # 22, Lines 14-18, which states these all happened kind of in two big blocks. Therefore, applicant was not informed by counsel on or off the record that these offenses should have been treated as continuous chain of one event, or a spree.

None did counsel fight for the applicant to be sentenced as such. Clearly the way that the applicant was sentenced he received no benefit from a plea and perhaps could have received less time by way of trial. Further, the trial Judge never gave applicant a chance to withdraw his plea once the trial Judge did not accept the recommendation, and counsel failed to protect that right.

Clearly pursuant to FRCP Rule 11, states that the court can't reject a plea agreement reached between the prosecutor and the defense. The court must inform the parties to the agreement that the agreement is rejected, and must inform the defendant that his or her plea can be withdrawn. Clearly the Record will reflect that the applicant was never given that chance.

FRCP Rule 11(e)(1)(B) states the court must advise the defendant that the defendant has no right to withdraw the plea if the court does not follow the recommendation or request. Pursuant to FRCP Rule 11(e)(1)(A) OR (C), the court must do the following on the Record and in open court (A) inform the parties that the court rejects the plea agreement; (B) advise the defendant personally that the court is not required to follow the plea agreement and give the defendant an opportunity to withdraw the plea; and (C) advise the defendant that if the plea is not withdrawn, the court may dispose of the case less favorably toward the defendant than the plea agreement contemplated. (C)

Therefore, since the applicant was not given the chance to withdraw his plea along with the other above mention mitigating factors, and only plead because of the recommendation of a ~~20~~²⁵ year sentence, said plea was not free and or voluntary with a full knowledge of the circumstances surrounding the Plea.

Findings of facts and conclusions of law

Set forth below are the relevant findings of facts and conclusions of law as required pursuant to SC Rule 317-27-80. In the allegations before this court the applicant is alleging that his plea was not voluntarily and intelligently made. See *Stok v. Armstrong*, 263 S.C. 544, 211 S.E. 2d 387 (1975)

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The South Carolina Supreme Court has held that the essence of Baykin was to make the requirements of Rule 11 of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure applicable to the states. The Supreme Court has held that for there to be a valid waiver under the due process clause of the three constitutional rights listed in Baykin, the record must clearly establish it. See Baykin v. Alabama, 315 U.S. 238, 89 S. Ct. 1709 (1969). A valid waiver of these rights cannot be preserved by a silent record. See Raddy v. State 339 S.C. 89, 529 S.E. 2d 418 (2000).



RETURN

The Respondent, making its Return to the application for post conviction relief (PCR) filed May 2, 2011, would respectfully show this Court:

I.

The Applicant is presently confined in the South Carolina Department of Corrections pursuant to orders of commitment of the Spartanburg County Clerk of Court. The Applicant was indicted at the March 2009 term of the Spartanburg County Grand Jury for five counts of forgery less than \$5,000 (09-GS-42-1413, -1414, -1415, -1416, -1802), receiving stolen goods less than \$1,000 (09-GS-42-1419), receiving stolen goods between \$1,000 and \$5,000 (09-GS-42-1420), and obtaining money by false pretenses (09-GS-42-1421). He was also indicted in October 2010 for two counts of petit larceny – 3rd or subsequent (10-GS-42-5616, -5617). He was represented by James A. Cheek, Esquire. On October 28, 2010, the Applicant pled guilty as indicted. He was sentenced by the Honorable J. Mark Hayes to confinement for ten years for each of the receiving stolen goods, obtaining money by false pretenses charges, forgery (09-1802), and petit larceny charges, all ordered to run concurrently. He also received ten years on each additional forgery charge, set to run

consecutive to other sentences received and the probation revocation, for an aggregate sentence of forty years. A *pro se* Motion for Resentencing was filed, but following a hearing, was denied by Judge Couch on December 17, 2010.

A timely notice of appeal was filed, but the South Carolina Court of Appeals dismissed the appeal on December 2, 2010, for a failure to demonstrate any issues preserved for appellate review. The Remittitur was returned on December 21, 2010.

Attached herewith and incorporated herein are the records of the Spartanburg County Clerk of Court regarding the subject conviction(s), the Applicant's records from the South Carolina Department of Corrections, Applicant's appellate records, and the guilty plea transcript. The Respondent reserves the right to amend this Return upon receipt of any relevant materials.

II.

In his current Application, the Applicant alleges that he is being held in custody unlawfully for the following reasons:

1. Ineffective assistance of counsel, in that;
 - a. A conflict of interest existed because Counsel (James Cheek) is associated with the Spartanburg Community Memorial Committee, which was a victim in the case and Clay Allen insured Applicant that James Cheek would not have anything to do with his case.
 - b. Applicant never received a copy of his discovery materials,
 - c. Counsel failed to object to the excessive sentence give by the Court when it exceeded the maximum authorized by law.
 - d. Counsel failed to file a Motion to withdraw guilty plea when the court failed to follow the State's recommendation,
 - e. Applicant signed a legally binding contract with the solicitor's office regarding a plea offer, which was not enforced.

III.

In a post-conviction relief action, the Applicant bears the burden of proving the allegations in their application. Butler v. State, 286 S.C. 441, 334 S.E.2d 813 (1985). Where the application alleges ineffective assistance of counsel as a ground for relief, the Applicant must prove that "counsel's conduct so undermined the proper functioning of the adversarial process that the trial cannot be relied upon as having produced a just result." Strickland v. Washington, 466 U.S. 668, 104 S.Ct. 2052, 2054, 80 L.Ed.2d 674, 692 (1984); Butler, 334 S.E.2d 813.

The proper measure of performance is whether the attorney provided representation within the range of competence required in criminal cases. The courts presume that counsel rendered adequate assistance and made all significant decisions in the exercise of reasonable professional judgment. Strickland, 466 U.S. 668. The Applicant must overcome this presumption in order to receive relief. Cherry v. State, 300 S.C. 115, 386 S.E.2d 624 (1989).

The reviewing court applies a two-pronged test in evaluating allegations of ineffective assistance of plea counsel. First, the Applicant must prove that counsel's performance was deficient. Under this prong, the court measures an attorney's performance by its "reasonableness under professional norms." Cherry, 300 S.C. at 117, 386 S.E.2d at 625, citing Strickland. Second, counsel's deficient performance must have prejudiced the Applicant such that "there is a reasonable probability that, but for counsel's unprofessional errors, the result of the proceeding would have been different." Cherry, 300 S.C. at 117-18, 386 S.E.2d at 625. With respect to guilty plea counsel, the Applicant must show that there is a reasonable probability that, but for counsel's alleged errors, he would not have pled guilty and would have insisted on going to trial. Hill v. Lockhart, 474 U.S. 52, 106 S.Ct. 366, 88 L.Ed. 2d 203 (1985).

The Respondent submits that the Applicant cannot satisfy either requirement of the Strickland test. However, the allegation of ineffective assistance of counsel probably raises questions of fact that the record does not conclusively refute. Accordingly, the Respondent requests an evidentiary hearing to fully resolve this issue. See Sharper v. State, 279 S.C. 264, 305 S.E.2d 247 (1983).

IV.

Each and every allegation contained within the application not hereinbefore expressly admitted, qualified or explained is hereby denied.

V.

WHEREFORE, having made its Return, the State requests that an evidentiary hearing be held.



Brief in Support of Writ-Certiorari

This matter comes before this Court by way of an application filed MAY 2, 2011. The respondent made its return on or about MAY 3, 2012. An evidentiary hearing into the matter was convened on November 9, 2012 at the Spartanburg County Courthouse. The Applicant was present at the hearing and was represented by Jonathan Bonds, Esq. Suzanne H. White, Esq., of the South Carolina Attorney General's office represented the Respondent. At the hearing, the Applicant testified on his own behalf, contending the excessive sentence in which he was indicted for the offenses of 5 counts of forgery less than \$5,000 (09-Cris-42-1413-1414-1415, 1416-1802), receiving stolen goods less than \$1,000 (09-Cris-42-1419), receiving stolen goods between \$1,000 and \$5,000 (09-Cris-42-1420) and obtaining money by false pretenses (09-Cris-42-1421). on Oct 29, 2010, the Applicant pled guilty as indicted. He was sentenced by the Hon ~~Boyer~~ ^{Boyer} Boyer to confinement for ten years for each of the forgery charges

He also received ten years for each of the receiving stolen goods, obtaining money by false pretenses charges, Forgery (09-1802) and Petit Larceny charges, all ordered to run concurrently.

He also received ~~ten~~ ten years on each additional forgery charge, set to run consecutive to other sentences received and the probation revocation, for an aggregate sentence of forty years. The Applicant also filed a pro se motion for resentencing that was filed, but was denied by Judge Couch on Dec 17, 2010. The applicant was placed on notice in the state conditional order of dismissal issued Jan 16th 2013, that he must file a notice of appeal within 30 days from the receipt by counsel of written notice of entry of judgment to secure the appropriate appellate review. See Rule 203, SCAH, pursuant to Austin v. State 305 S.C. 453 (1991) an Applicant has a right to an appellate counsel's assistance in seeking review of the denial of PCR. Rule 71.1 (9) SCLER. Provides that if the applicant wishes to seek ~~appropriate~~ appellate review. The applicant concedes that issue raised within PCR was adjudicated based on facts and conclusion of case law within the order of dismissal issued 16th of JAN 2013

Applicant states the claim that his sentence exceeds the maximum sentence permitted by S.C. Code of Laws. This claim is supported by the Penal Code under S.C. Code 16-13-10 Forfeit; which states: Section 16-13-10 B (2) Felony and, upon conviction, must be fined in the discretion of the court or imprisoned not more than five years, or both if the amount of the Forfeit is less than five thousand dollars." The sentencing sheet applicant received indicate: reflecting Indictment Case# 2009CG5420 1413-1414 1415, that all offenses applicant pled guilty to was less than 5,000 thousand dollars (see attached sentencing sheets, Applicant counsel failure to object to the trial court judge sentencing applicant outside the statutory authority of Forfeit. Trial Court Judge misconstrued the language of 16-13-10 - Forfeit and sentenced applicant to the subsection of 16-13-10 B (1) which states: Felony and, upon conviction, must be fined in the discretion of the court or imprisoned not more than ten years, or both, if the amount of the Forfeit is five thousand or more. The applicant received a restitution ~~and~~ order that was signed Oct 28th 2010 see attached order, showing each of the four Indictment evidence of the pecuniary damage and loss to the victim, none of these four counts show a value over \$5,000 dollars to put applicants sentence within the

Sentencing Range of S.C. Code 16-13-10 Forger (B) 1
to allow applicant to be subjected to the sentencing of
10 years, based on these foregoing facts the applicant
is entitled to appellate review by the Supreme Court
to have current sentence and conviction ~~be~~ remanded for
resentence. Trial counsel for applicant was ineffective
for failure to object to illegal sentence, the proper
measure of performance is whether the Attorney
provided representation within the range of competence
required in criminal cases, the applicant must show
counsel performance was deficient, and as a result
prejudiced the Applicant such that there is a reasonable
probability that but for counsel's unprofessional errors
the result of the proceeding would have been different.
A reasonable probability is a probability sufficient
to undermine confidence in the outcome of trial.
The deficient performance was trial counsel having no
knowledge of S.C. Code 16-13-10 B 2, had counsel
would have had clarity of said statute applicant
would have been sentenced in conformity of 5 years
of each count, resulting in a 20 years, instead of
40 yr sentence. State v. Fowler No. 21676 the
Supreme Court hold "A sentence imposed in excess of
statutory authority requires remanding the case for
resentencing in conformity with the applicable statutes

Conclusion

STATE v. Hill, 254 S.C. 321, 175 S.E. 2d 227 (1970)

If the forgery does not involve a dollar amount, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, must be fined in the discretion of the court or imprisoned not more than three years, or both.

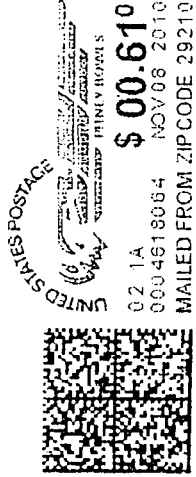

It is clear that by reviewing the sentence sheets and indictments that the Sentencing Judge exceeded the guidelines, and violated S. C. Code of law (1976) and § 17-27-20. A Counsel did not object, or inform Applicant properly that the Court on his guilty plea was going to exceed Five years or do anything to stop the Court from giving Applicant Four ten year, and consecutive sentences on original misdemeanor charges.

When Applicant entered a guilty plea he was expecting some relief and the benefit of their bargain Counsel should have at all had Applicant's best interest in this representation of sentencing.
