Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The appellant's initial brief must contain a cover in compliance with Rule 267, SCACR.
- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.
- The appellant's initial brief must contain the content outlined by Rule 208(b), SCACR. Specifically, the appellant's initial brief must contain a table of contents, statement of issues on appeal, statement of the case, standard of review, argument, and conclusion.
