ORDER

After careful consideration, Respondent's motion to dismiss this appeal is granted. *See Mathis v. S.C. State Highway Dep't*, 260 S.C. 344, 346, 195 S.E.2d 713, 715 (1973) ("A case becomes moot when judgment, if rendered, will have no practical legal effect upon [any] existing controversy. This is true when some event occurs making it impossible for [the] reviewing [c]ourt to grant effectual relief."); *Nelson v. Ozmint*, 390 S.C. 432, 434, 702 S.E.2d 369, 370 (2010) ("[P]etitioner was released from SCDC . . . making his underlying claim moot.").
