**MOTION TO EXPEDITE AND CONSOLIDATE**

---

Pursuant to Rules 240 & 214, SCACR, Respondent Stephen Woodard moves to expedite the consideration of this matter and consolidate it with Court of Appeals case number 2022-000861. On December 29, 2022, Appellant sent this Court a “Notice of Appeal”, but this document does not include an order of a lower court that is being appealed, and it did not include the required \$250.00 filing fee. It is apparent this “Notice of Appeal” was intended to be a motion to reconsider of some fashion in Appellant’s original appeal (2022-000861), as it references the same Berkeley County Case number (2022-CP-08-01083).

As set forth in the Motion to Expedite and for Sanctions in 2022-000861 (incorporated herein by reference), the “Notice of Appeal” appears to be part of a larger attempt to delay remittitur of this matter and continue living rent-free in Respondent’s property, which she has done

**for the past ten months.** Further, the police reports attached to Respondent's motion in 2022-000861 (attached to this motion as an exhibit) show Appellant has been harboring dangerous criminals in Respondent's property for nearly a year; **expediting the resolution of this eviction is now also an urgent matter of public safety.**

Accordingly, Respondent would ask this Court to consolidate this matter, with all due haste, with Appellant's original appeal (2022-000861) and dispose of it promptly. Respondent would further request the Court issue some manner of interim guidance to the lower courts authorizing them to proceed with eviction - while an appeal does not normally stay a writ of ejectment (Rule 241(b)(10), SCACR), the lower courts appear hesitant to proceed due to the muddled nature of Appellant's *pro se* pleadings.

Carolinas Regional Fugitive Task Force members and Berkeley County Sheriff's Office K-9 units then made contact at 115 Hayworth Road, and it was at time, [REDACTED] surrendered and exited the front door of the residence and was arrested.

Sgt. Milks obtained a search warrant for the residence and executed by Sgt. Milks and Sgt. Leonard Cain of the Orangeburg County Sheriff's Office. One item seized, iPhone belonging to [REDACTED] recovered by Sgt. Cain. Who took possession of item. Sgt.
