ORDER

By order dated November 22, 2022, the South Carolina Court of Appeals dismissed the appeal in this matter.¹ Petitioner has now filed a document which has been construed as a petition for a writ of certiorari to review the decision of the Court of Appeals. He also asks this Court to appoint counsel.

Because Petitioner failed to file a petition for rehearing or reinstatement from the Court of Appeals' order of dismissal and because the remittitur has now been sent pursuant to Rule 221 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), Petitioner's petition for a writ of certiorari is stricken and dismissed. *See* Rule 242(a), SCACR (providing this Court will only review a final decision of the Court of Appeals); Rule 242(c), SCACR (providing a decision is not final for the purposes of review until a petition for rehearing or reinstatement has been acted on by the Court of Appeals); *Stogsdill v. S.C. Dep't of Health & Human Servs.*, 415 S.C. 568, 784 S.E.2d 669 (2016) (stating the sending of the remittitur ends appellate jurisdiction over a case).

The motion to appoint counsel is denied as moot.
