MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT RECORD ON APPEAL

The Appellant, Theodore Bolick pursuant to Rule 212 (b) SCACR, hereby moves the court for an order allowing the Appellant to supplement the Record on Appeal in order to address the issue presented by the Respondent in its Initial Brief that the Appellant was somehow at fault for not being heard on his pro se Motion For Mistrial and Motion For New Trial on September 16, 2020 at the Appellant's

1. 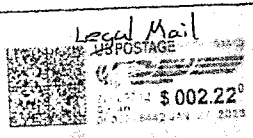
