MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO  
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Bowen Gray Turner respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from February 2, 2023 until March 6, 2023**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Bowen Gray Turner respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of James A. Gardner v. State, with this Court on Wednesday, January 18, 2023. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the murder case of Kenneth Tyrone Wherry v. The State with this Court on January 12, 2023. Counsel conducted a CLE presentation and training on Preserving the Record for Appellate Review for the Fifth Circuit Public Defender's Office on January 6, 2023. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Respondent in the case of The State v. Bowen Gray Turner In Re: Victim C.B. with this Court on December 22, 2022. Counsel filed the Brief of Respondent in the case of John Perry v. The State with the Supreme Court on December 15, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Marcus McFadden v. The State with the Supreme Court on December 14, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals and the Appendix in the murder case of Malette Denise Kimbrough v. The State with the Supreme Court on December 1, 2022. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the murder case of The State v. Donovan Brannon with this Court on November 18, 2022. Counsel filed the Brief of Respondent in the murder case of The State v. Robert Xavier Geter with the Supreme Court on November 14, 2022. Counsel filed the Motion for Stay of Execution and for the Appointment of a Post-Conviction Relief Judge in the death penalty case of The State v. Jerome Jenkins. Jr. with the Supreme Court on Thursday, November 10, 2022. Counsel, with co-counsel David Alexander and Lara M. Caudy, filed the brief of petitioner in the death penalty case of Marion Alexander Lindsey v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 4, 2022. **Counsel also has extensive administrative duties as the Chief Appellate Defender.**

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




