MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.

2. Counsel filed the *Anders* Brief of Appellant and the Record on Appeal in the case of the State v. Bobby Ray McClure, Jr. with this Court on January 30, 2023. Counsel filed the Reply to Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari Pursuant to *Mack v. State* in the case of John Willie Mack, Sr. v. The State with this Court on January 13, 2023. Counsel filed the Petition for


Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Samuel Jeter v. The State with the Supreme Court on January 6, 2023. Counsel filed the Petition for Certiorari to the Court of Appeals and the Appendix in the case of The State v. Amy N. Taylor with the Supreme Court December 6, 2022.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




