MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SERVE AND FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Petitioner respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Petitioner respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Antly Jermaine Scott with the Court of Appeals on February 1, 2023. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Tammy G. Harris v. State with the Supreme Court on January 25, 2023. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Perez Brooks v. State with the Supreme Court on January 17, 2023. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation in the case of State v. Kendrick Blackwell with the Court of Appeals on January 6, 2023. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant in the case of State v. Samuel Aaron with the Court of Appeals on December 21, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Jarret Graddick v. State with the Court of Appeals on December 12, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of William Bruce Justice v. State with the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals on December 6, 2022. Counsel appeared before the Court of Appeals for Oral Argument in the case of Mitchell Rivers v. State on December 6, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


