He refused so back in March 2022 after the incident I filed an Eviction on him I went to magistrate to get a copy of it. It is attached to this letter after he was served he left 3 wks after that. He haven't been staying in my residents since. Janynda said she be seeing him, I told her just because she sees him out there don't mean he at my house. He knows more than just me that stays out there then Janynda said he was on my porch he must be there when I was at work because I haven't seen him at my house. Judge Arelus I have no where else to go and I have a child I need the place for her. All I do is work come home and make sure my baby go to school. I don't be in the streets or hanging out I go to bible study on Thursdays and regular church on Sundays, where I am an usher. I'm trying to be the best I can be for my child and me.
