MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

2. Counsel for Petitioner respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions


previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Jared Scott Childress v. State with the Supreme Court on December 7, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Derrick Miles with the Supreme Court on December 2, 2022.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
