On January 25, 2023, this Court issued an unpublished decision in the above-referenced post-conviction relief appeal reversing and remanding for a new evidentiary. Pursuant to Rule 221(a) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, any petition for rehearing would be need to be served and filed no later than Thursday, February 9, 2023.

At present, the State intends to file a petition for rehearing in this appeal. However, due to a heavy workload coupled with my preparations for two Supreme Court oral arguments scheduled to be held in Conway on Wednesday, February 8, 2023, I have not yet been able to complete the petition and am requesting a ten-day extension to serve and file it. This is the **first** extension request in connection to the petition, and it is not intended for the purpose of delay.
