REASON FOR AFFIANT'S BELIEF THAT THE  
PROPERTY SOUGHT IS ON THE SUBJECT PREMISES


On March 14, 2017, Lindsey Nicole Lee was discovered deceased inside of her residence located at [REDACTED] Haleywood Lane, West Columbia, SC, in the County of Lexington, by a Deputy from the Lexington County Sheriff's Department (LCSD), upon conducting a welfare check after she did not arrive at LCSD for work. The responding LCSD Deputies noticed that someone had appeared to make forced entry into L. Lee's residence, while entering to clear the residence. While clearing the residence, LCSD Deputies heard the shower running in the bathroom and noticed that the door was closed. LCSD Deputies opened the bathroom door, turned the light on, pulled the shower curtain back and noticed L. Lee in the bathtub with a large wound to her neck. LCSD Deputies exited the residence, and contacted the proper authorities. The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) was requested to conduct the investigation. The SLED Crime Scene Unit collected significant evidence from the residence which was later processed by the SLED Forensic Sciences Unit. SLED Agents interviewed numerous individuals, to include L. Lee's estranged husband, Jason Donn Lee. J. Lee had several interactions with SLED Agents between March 14, 2017 and March 16, 2017, and voluntarily gave numerous conflicting and deceptive statements. During the initial contact with SLED Agents, J. Lee had noticeably fresh injuries in the form of scratch marks and a small puncture wound to the palm of his hand. On March 17, 2017, the SLED Forensic Services Unit generated a report which implicated J. Lee as a major DNA contributor to a piece of evidence inside of the residence where L. Lee had appeared to have been attacked as she arrived home. J. Lee was subsequently arrested and charged with forcibly entering L. Lee's residence and murdering her. Upon arrest, SLED Agents also noticed an injury to J. Lee's arm.

After obtaining multiple Search Warrants of J. Lee's phone, other electronic devices, and various accounts, it was discovered that he had deleted multiple applications from his cellular phone shortly after murder and burglary occurred, some of which were synchronized with his Gmail account.

It is the Affiant's belief that email and social media providers, such as Google and/or Gmail have the capability to preserve and store personal information, in the form of any and all types of email correspondence, to include synchronized applications from various merchandisers and service providers, which is readily accessible to Law Enforcement agencies for investigational purposes. Additionally, this request is based on the fact that after reviewing the extraction report from J. Lee's personal phone it appears that he deleted his search history and/or reset his phone after initial contact with SLED agents. Further, SLED Agents are requesting this evidence to assist with the ongoing criminal investigation of Murder and Burglary 1st Degree.

REASON FOR AFFIANT'S BELIEF THAT THE  
PROPERTY SOUGHT IS ON THE SUBJECT PREMISES

On March 14, 2017, Lindsey Nicole Lee was discovered deceased inside of her residence located at [REDACTED] Haleywood Lane, West Columbia, SC, in the County of Lexington, by a Deputy from the Lexington County Sheriff's Department (LCSD), upon conducting a welfare check after she did not arrive at LCSD for work. The responding LCSD Deputies noticed that someone had appeared to make forced entry into L. Lee's residence, while entering to clear the residence. While clearing the residence, LCSD Deputies heard the shower running in the bathroom and noticed that the door was closed. LCSD Deputies opened the bathroom door, turned the light on, pulled the shower curtain back



and noticed L. Lee in the bathtub with a large wound to her neck. LCSD Deputies exited the residence, and contacted the proper authorities. The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) was requested to conduct the investigation. The SLED Crime Scene Unit collected significant evidence from the residence which was later processed by the SLED Forensic Sciences Unit. SLED Agents interviewed numerous individuals, to include L. Lee's estranged husband, Jason Donn Lee. J. Lee had several interactions with SLED Agents between March 14, 2017 and March 16, 2017, and voluntarily gave numerous conflicting and deceptive statements. During the initial contact with SLED Agents, J. Lee had noticeably fresh injuries in the form of scratch marks and a small puncture wound to the palm of his hand.

On March 17, 2017, the SLED Forensic Services Unit generated a report which implicated J. Lee as a major DNA contributor to a piece of evidence inside of the residence where L. Lee had appeared to have been attacked as she arrived home. J. Lee was subsequently arrested and charged with forcibly entering L. Lee's residence and murdering her. Upon arrest, SLED Agents also noticed an additional injury to J. Lee's arm which was in the process of healing. An additional DNA analysis report also documented the discovery of J. Lee's DNA on a plastic bag located inside of the glove compartment of L. Lee's vehicle.

J. Lee voluntarily provided his cellular phone to SLED Agents during the initial interview, with telephone number [REDACTED]-9960. Based on the injuries to J. Lee's hand and face, which were observed and documented, the Affiant believes it is pertinent to have the above requested information to assist with determining the location of J. Lee during the murder of L. Lee, as well as the burglary to her residence, in order to establish or verify a timeline.

*Charge on facts*

The defendant contends that there is evidence before you indicating that someone other than he or she may have committed the crime or crimes, and that evidence raises a reasonable doubt with respect to the defendant's guilt. In this regard, I charge you that a defendant in a criminal case has the right to rely on any evidence produced at trial that has a rational tendency to raise a reasonable doubt with respect to his/her own guilt. I have previously charged you with regard to the state's burden of proof, which never shifts to the defendant. The defendant does not have to produce evidence that proves the guilt of another, but may rely on evidence that creates a reasonable doubt. In other words, there is no requirement that this evidence proves or even raises a strong probability that someone else other than the defendant committed the crime. You must decide whether the state has proven the defendant's guilt beyond a reasonable doubt not whether the other person or persons may have committed the crimes.

The defendant claims that he was not at the scene of the crime at the time it was committed. In other words, the defendant claims that he was elsewhere and had nothing to do with the crime.


This claim is sometimes referred to as the "defense" of alibi. However, an alibi claim is not really a defense because the claim does not impose any burden upon the defendant to prove his alibi.

The State has the burden of proving the identity of the person who committed the alleged crime.

Thus, the burden is upon the state to prove that the defendant was actually present at the scene of the crime, that he or she actually participated in it, and that he or she was not elsewhere.

Thus, the state must prove presence and participation by evidence beyond a reasonable-doubt.

If you have a reasonable doubt as to whether the defendant was present, you must resolve this doubt in favor of the defendant and find him not-guilty.
