## ORDER

---

Respondents have filed a motion to dismiss based on Appellant's failure to file and serve a Record on Appeal that complies with Rule 210, SCACR. On April 21, 2022, this Court struck the record on appeal originally filed and ordered Appellant to serve and file an amended record on appeal that included all matters designated by both parties and omits any matter not presented to the lower court. On October 21, 2022, this Court granted Respondent's motion to strike the amended record on appeal and ordered Appellant to serve and file a second amended record on appeal that included full copies of all matter designated by the parties. The Court warned failure to comply may result in dismissal. On December 2, 2022, Appellant filed a Record on Appeal, which fails to include all of the Respondents' designated matters. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record on Appeal shall include all matter designated to be included by any party under Rule 209 . . ."). Accordingly, Respondent's motion to dismiss is granted. The remittitur will be sent as required by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
