Upon reviewing your appellant's final brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The document is not accompanied by the certificate of counsel required by Rule 211, SCACR.
- The content of the document does not follow Rule 211(b), SCACR, which states that the final brief shall be identical to the initial brief except for references to the record and correction of typographical errors and misspellings.
- The binding of your final brief is improper pursuant to Rule 267, SCACR. Spiral binding, staples/clasps going down the left side and covered in heavy book binding tape, or report folders without a glassine cover are options that will be accepted. Binders, colored pocket folders, and sheet protectors may not be used.
