**MOTION FOR THIRD EXTENSION  
TO SERVE AND FILE APPENDIX AND  
PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI**

Petitioner, by and through its undersigned counsel, would respectfully show  
unto this Court as follows:

I.

The Petition for a Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be filed and served today, February 17, 2023. Pursuant to RE: *Extension Requests in Criminal Direct Appeals and Post-Conviction Relief Certiorari Proceedings*: Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009, the Petitioner respectfully requests a third extension in the above referenced appeal upon a showing of good cause.

Counsel is a solo practitioner as well as a part-time assistant solicitor with the 6<sup>th</sup> Circuit Solicitor's Office.
