MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

Counsel for appellant respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from February 17, 2023, until March 20, 2023**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for appellant respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel is attending the South Carolina Bar Board of Governor's Retreat from February 16-18, 2023. State with the Supreme Court on January 25, 2023. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Perez Brooks v. State with the Supreme Court on January 17, 2023. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation in the case of State v. Kendrick Blackwell with the Court of Appeals on January 6, 2023. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant in the case of State v. Samuel Aaron with the Court of Appeals on December 21, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Jarret Graddick v. State with the Court of Appeals on December 12, 2022.




