**MOTION FOR THIRD EXTENSION OF DEADLINE TO SERVE AND FILE
PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX AND MOTION TO
FILE EXTENSION REQUEST OUT OF TIME**

Petitioner hereby moves for a third extension of time in which to serve and file its petition for writ of certiorari and appendix and moves for the Court to accept the request even though it is being filed out of time. In support of this motion, the undersigned shows the following.

1. Petitioner's petition for writ of certiorari and appendix were due to be served and filed yesterday.
2. The undersigned intended to request a third extension to the service and filing deadline yesterday but neglected to serve and file it by the end of the day.
3. This Court has the authority to relax the time requirements and to accept this third extension request even though it is being filed one day late. *See* Rule

263(b), SCACR (“The time prescribed by these Rules for performing any act except the time for serving the notice of appeal under Rule 203 and 243 may be extended or shortened by the appellate court, or by any judge or justice thereof.”).

4. Petitioner is respectfully requesting a third extension to the filing and service deadline by way of this motion. The request is not intended for the purpose of delay. Rather, it is necessitated by the undersigned’s heavy workload.
5. Respondent has consented to a third extension by way of an inter-agency agreement between the Office of Appellate Defense and the Attorney General’s Office and counsel for Respondent notified the undersigned by email today that she has no objection to this motion.


