That QUINTON MAURICE COLLINS did in Pickens County, on or about the 14th day of December, 2018, while acting in concert with co-defendant TYCHRISTIAN LADSON, did unlawfully and with malice aforethought kill STACEY BRANHAM by means of shooting the victim and STACEY BRANHAM died as a proximate result thereof during an attempted armed robbery of the victim's place of employment, B-PAMS CONVENIENCE STORE. 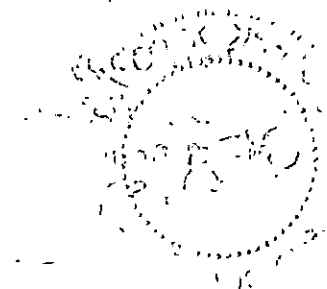
