ORDER

This appeal was dismissed due to Appellant's failure to serve and file a Designation of Matter. On February 17, 2012, this Court sent Appellant a letter indicating that in order for his appeal to be reinstated, Appellant had to file a petition to reinstate, file a "Corrected Appellant's Initial Brief" that did not include changes to the content of his brief, and file a Designation of Matter. Appellant has now served and filed an amended Designation of Matter, a petition to reinstate this appeal, an amended Appellant's Initial Brief, and a motion to change and add content to his initial brief.
