

ORDER

Appellant filed a motion dated March 3, 2023, seeking an order of the Court directing the Commission on Indigent Defense to assume the costs of printing materials for the purpose of pursuing this appeal. This remedy was requested on December 28, 2022, and the request was denied on January 13, 2023.

The Supreme Court issued an order restricting Appellant's ability to file and directing the Clerks of Court of this State to deliver all filings made by Appellant to the Chief Judge to determine whether the filing complies with the restrictions. *See In the Matter of Marie Assa'ad-Faltas*, S.C. Sup. Ct. Order dated June 10, 2022. Appellant's motion dated March 3, 2023, is not a document required to be filed in this appeal. Accordingly, the motion is dismissed with prejudice. We remind Appellant she may be held in contempt for violations of the Supreme Court's orders restricting her filings.
