Upon reviewing your client's correspondence which we construe as a notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- A Notice of Appeal was not provided. You must provide a Notice of Appeal pursuant to Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Your notice of appeal must be submitted in the format shown in Part II, Appendix C of the SCACR.

Order dated August 25, 2021 (Howard Adv. Sh. No. 30), only lawyers admitted to practice in South Carolina may serve other lawyers using the lawyer's primary email address in AIS. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.

- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The notice of appeal was not filed with the lower trial court as required by Rule 203(d)(1)(B), SCACR
