MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO FILE
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for petitioner respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until April 10, 2023**, in which to file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for petitioner respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Christopher Wilbert Keitt v. State with the Supreme Court on December 16, 2022. Counsel filed Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant In The interest of Jah'ki B., a Juvenile Under the Age of Seventeen, with the Court of Appeals on December 12, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


