

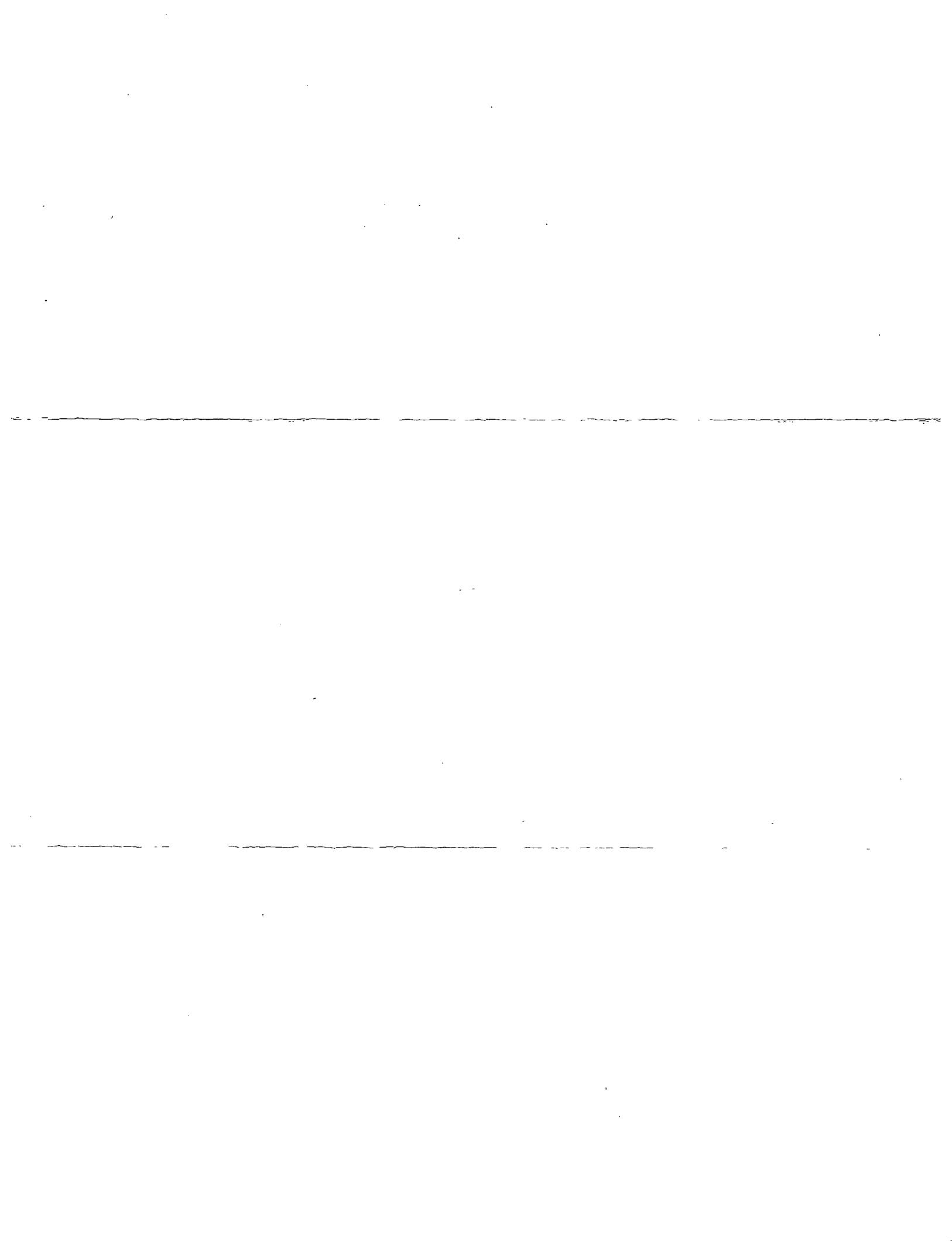
Dear Mr. Temple,




As of now, I have gathered together all the documents, motions, orders, pleadings and exhibits in this case, which exceed 100 pages, and more like 200 pages.


