I, Roland L D Green, am motioning the court to allow me to terminate my client/attorney relationship with Lir Patrick Derieg.

My grounds for the motion are as follows:

During the 22 months that Mr Derieg has been my attorney, I have actually verbally spoke to him only a handful of times. I have seen him in his office only one time, and if i needed to converse with him or send him documentation for my case, it was only done so by facebook messenger. He put forth no effort to build my case or contact my witnesses. He has only showed up to represent me in court twice, both times for sentencing and both times he misspoke on sentencing and instructed me to take pleas that he was knowingly dishonest about. Many of our FB messenger conversations and important documentation for my case that he was sent, he claimed he "lost" and

He also actually called me one morning just a few days after my release from incarceration. With no prior notice, he said I had missed a court date that morning on this case. He told me to make it to the courthouse before noon and tell them I wanted a jury trial. He said if I didn't get there and didn't request a jury trial I'd be going back to prison. He had my number and a backup number but failed to let me know about the court date. I was in work clothes and at work in another town barely made it there in time. There was no notice, no preparation, no discussion. He did not show up. He left me no option but to request for a jury trial.

- When trying to discuss my case via messenger, he would often have to be reminded of things we had previously discussed and even things he had previously stated and would begin to argue that

He never said what I was inquiring about, until I would send him screenshots of our conversations.

★ On february 14th 2023
I went into the courtroom thinking I was there for general sessions rollcall, because that is what mr. Dering told me was the reason for court that day. That I would give evidence on the case of mine. on the 20th of february at my trial, Theyfore I had none of my evidence, paperwork, witnesses, statements there with me... Only to find that I would be seeing the judge and sentenced. The first thing he said to me and a trusted Christian lady who came with me, "the solicitor said if we present the car rental reciept and could speak to my witnesses, so do you have the reciept"? I told him that I had nothing with me because he told me this was just roll call, and that he had been sent a copy of the reciept and even long before that. He had

previously said he'd already discussed this with the solicitor. However in court he stated that he had lost it. Something that left me dumbfounded. So, i then said that i could call home and ask for it to be sent to me and then ask the court to print it out for me. He said that wouldn't work but get it printed and to him as soon as we could. Then began to walk off. Then he approached us a few minutes later and said that they were going to discuss if he was gonna still be my attorney. I had originally planned to ask the judge to let me fire Mr. Derieg and give me time to seek other counsel. The only reason i changed my mind is because he said that the charge would be dropped when we first arrived. During the court appearance Mr. Derieg made zero effort to present my case and simply came to me again and with a plea of 12 to 18 mths of probation. Something

I wasn't really comfortable with because it was stating something I did not do, but Mr Derieg insisted it was something I should do to get it all behind me and had me sign a plea deal. Then he left with a paper only to return with a paper saying I was giving 5 yrs probation and \$59,000 restitution for something I did not do. A plea I would not have accepted. I asked Mr Derieg how we went from getting the charge dismissed to 5 yrs probation and 59,000 restitution he wrambled stating well when they realized the monetary value, (something the court was already aware of) the solicitor withdrew the offer. I never saw him go and speak to the solicitor that was seated directly in front of me and my friend. After he originally offered to have the charges dropped, he went and set alone except to talk to me. After the appearance on Feb 14th 2023 Mr Derieg then projected himself in the Court documents ^{perjured} himself in the

As He went to the judge and turned in a paper before court stating the grounds of his dismissal was lack of payment. He told the judge that I only made 1 payment of \$400. Which is a blatant lie. I have receipts showing that I have paid him thousands for this case. He sent intimidating fb messages a couple days before court that if i didn't pay him thousands of more dollars that I would be in court alone. He obviously lost receipts, documents, and conversations. He was very incompetent and unreliable with several things. Yet, I was served papers that he quit and that is what i believed.

Mr Derieg has himself been arrested several times (3 or 4) times over the past 6 months for drunk and disorderly behavior. Leaving the scene of an accident. This is something that causes me to wonder if he is suffering from a serious addiction problem that would explain his disorganization, rambling, and bad attitude




