ORDER

This court issued an order on January 10, 2023, granting Appellant a fourth extension to file his initial appellant's brief, and advising Appellant that any further extension request must show the existence of extraordinary circumstances, as well as steps Appellant has taken to prevent any further delay. On February 6, 2023, two days before the new deadline for filing his initial appellant's brief, Appellant filed a motion to hold this appeal in abeyance. Appellant explained that he inadvertently failed to order the transcripts of pre-trial hearings, which contain substantive matters relevant to this appeal.

More than thirty days has now elapsed since the deadline for filing Appellant's initial brief, after four prior extensions. Accordingly, within ten days of the date of this order, Appellant shall file either his initial appellant's brief, or a status update on the pre-trial hearing transcripts along with documentation of any and all correspondence with the court reporter. Failure to comply will result in dismissal of this appeal.
