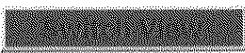

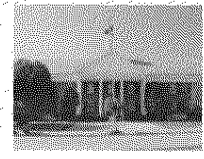

**Narrative**

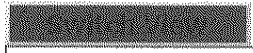
On 01/21/2023 I Deputy Navarreesquivel responded to I/L in reference to a suspicious person. When I arrived I made contact with Lir Derieg (offender). Lir was sitting at a table inside the I/L directly next to the cash register, where the complainant Alaysha Nicholson was standing. Alaysha stated Lir got out of his vehicle and walked inside and sat down. Alaysha stated he sat there for almost an hour before she called R/O. When I attempted to speak to Lir, Lir looked at me with a blank face and appeared to struggle keeping his eyes open. I attempted to come closer to Lir to speak louder so he could hear me, to which point I could smell a strong odor of alcohol emitting from Lir. I attempted a final time to ask Lir what he was doing and how many alcoholic beverages he consumed today, to which point Lir couldn't speak and struggled to keep his eyes open still. I then arrested Lir for Public Disorderly Conduct. Upon searching Lir incident to arrest, I found his keys in his pocket, which came back to the black jeep that was on and running in the parking space next to my patrol car. Deputy Hernandez completed a tow sheet and had the vehicle towed by All Around Towing while I transported Lir to ACDC. Lir was issued UTT 8102P0883868 for Public Disorderly Conduct which is in violation of SC Code Of Laws, As Amended. Lir was then transferred to ARMC for a medical clearance. Once cleared, Lir was transferred back to ACDC where he was processed. I have no further.

**Narrative**

R/O responded to the above I/L in reference to a private property hit and run. R/O arrived on scene and spoke to the victim, the driver of the listed Ram truck. He stated that he was sitting in his truck when the offender pulled into the parking spot next to him and struck his vehicle. R/O observed a large area on the driver's side of the victim's vehicle that was scratched. R/O observed that there was dirt and dust all over the side of the victim's truck except where the door was scratched. R/O observed a large area on the driver's door, at least a foot long, where the paint was completely scratched off and the white primer was visible. The victim stated that he told the offender he hit his vehicle and the offender continued into the store and made a purchase. He stated that the offender told him he did not hit his car. The victim stated that he told the offender he was going to call law enforcement and to stay on scene. The victim stated that the offender did not provide any vehicle or insurance information and told the victim he was leaving. The victim stated that the offender only left him with a piece of paper with his name and address on it. R/O was unable to read the name due to the poor handwriting. R/O was able to read the address. The victim stated that the offender appeared to be extremely intoxicated and smelled like alcohol. R/O spoke to the clerk (witness) who also stated that the offender appeared to be intoxicated. He showed R/O video of the incident. R/O observed the victim sitting in his vehicle in the parking lot. R/O then observed the offender pull into the parking spot next to the victim. R/O observed that the offender struck the victim's driver's side with the front passenger's side of his vehicle. R/O observed that the victim's vehicle slightly moved from the impact. R/O then observed the offender look at the area where the vehicle's collided. R/O observed the offender to be wearing a dark hoodie and dark shorts. The victim provided R/O with the offender's tag number that matched the vehicle description. The clerk advised he would send R/O the video for evidence. R/O responded to 46 Boyd Drive and met with the offender. R/O observed the listed offender's vehicle with the tag number matching that provided by the victim located at 46 Boyd Drive. The offender came outside and spoke to R/O. R/O immediately observed that the offender smelled strongly of alcohol and was swaying slightly as he was standing. R/O asked what happened at the store and the offender initially stated nothing happened. When R/O provided the offender with the information on the incident, the offender stated that he left because he did not believe that he hit the victim's vehicle. He stated that he already had damage to his vehicle from a previous accident. R/O observed the offender's vehicle and found that the front passenger's side quarter panel had a fresh scratch. R/O observed that there was white primer residue on the front that wiped off on R/O finger. This residue was consistent with the primer that was visible on the victim's door. R/O asked the offender if he has been drinking and he stated that he started drinking as soon as he got home from the store. R/O observed he was grossly intoxicated and had to sit on the step or lean on the wall for support. R/O asked the offender why he left the scene of the accident and he stated he did not believe that he hit the victim's truck. R/O asked him why he did not stay after the victim told him law enforcement was on the way and he advised that he did not believe the victim was actually calling 911. R/O issued the offender a citation for leaving the scene of a property damage accident. R/O provided the victim with report number and information on the offender's vehicle for insurance purposes. R/O has no further.
