## ORDER

After careful consideration, Respondent's motion to require an amended record on appeal is granted. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended record on appeal that contains all of Respondent's designated matter, consecutive pagination, and only contains documents that were presented to the lower court. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record on Appeal shall include all matter designated to be included by any party under Rule 209 and shall comply with the requirements of Rule 267. The Record shall not, however, include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal. . . . Each page of the Record on Appeal shall be numbered consecutively beginning with the index.").
