

## ORDER

---

Respondent's motion to strike Appellant's final brief, designation of matter, and record on appeal, all filed on January 20, 2023 as a single document, is granted. Within thirty days of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended record on appeal, which contains all of Respondent's designated matters—filed November 29, 2022—and which contains no documents that were not presented to the lower court. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record on Appeal shall include all matter designated to be included by any party under Rule 209 and shall comply with the requirements of Rule 267. The Record shall not, however, include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal."). Failure to comply may result in dismissal of this appeal.

Within twenty days of service of the record on appeal, each party shall serve and file their final brief, which shall be identical to their initial brief, aside from references to the record on appeal and the correction of typographical errors, pursuant to Rule 211 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
