Goods and services are requested to continue at a decreased amount as advocated due to the illegal practices of mail fraud, and consumer violations of illegal price increases. A stay of the said practices is requested.

information. The court must then notify the Appellant of the right to respond or appear in court, if such filing is approved. A Stay of the illegal practice of the Appellant being pulled over by officers and arresting Conspiracies (bench warrants, etc) is requested as, the said practices constitute as illegal business practices and scams, and subject to prosecution. 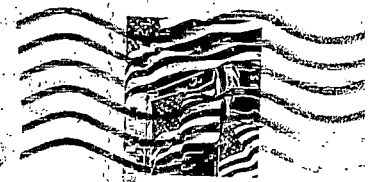
