 MOTION TO DISMISS



This matter comes before me upon Applicant's Motion to Alter or Amend the Judgment filed by the Applicant and the Applicant's Motion to Reconsider Sentence filed on behalf of the Applicant by his Attorney, Mark A. Peper.

Application for post-conviction relief was initially filed on November 8, 2011. The Respondent made its Return on May 1, 2012. This Court presided over an evidentiary hearing relief on January 22, 2013 in Charleston County. Applicant's PCR application was denied and dismissed with prejudice.
