I.

The Initial Brief Of Respondent and Designation Of Matter are due to the Court today, pursuant to two previous extensions granted by the Court.

II.

Due to work required in other cases pending before this Court, the South Carolina, and the circuit courts, I am unable to complete this brief and designation on time. Since the last extension was requested, I have filed Initial Briefs Of Respondent and Designations Of Matter in State v. Demetrius Deon Thompson (2021-001254) and State v. Michael Isaac Mobley (2022-000450). In addition to these matters I have been preparing for a trial that was scheduled

to begin in the Sumter County Court of General Sessions, State v. Christopher Chantell Billie (2019GS4300677). Yesterday, the defendant in that matter decided to take a plea, and I. have been drafting the plea agreement. State (2022-CP-42-04095) and Vincente Baños v. State (2020-CP-11-0001). I would therefore request an extension of time within which to serve and file the Initial Brief Of Respondent and Designation Of Matter.
