MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

Counsel for Michael T. Quarles respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of State v. Leslie Keiffer with the Court of Appeals on March 14, 2023. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and accompanying Appendix in the case of The State v. Xzariera Okevis Gray with the Supreme Court on March 6, 2023.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. On April 4, 2023, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through April 30, 2023.
