ORDER

After careful consideration, Respondents' motion to strike Appellant's initial brief and designation of matter is granted. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file a designation of matter and initial brief that comply with Rules 208, 209, and 210 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. See Rule 208(b), SCACR (detailing the proper content and format of initial briefs); Rule 209(b), SCACR (providing the designation of matter "must clearly identify what the party desires to have included in the Record on Appeal" and "); Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record shall not . . . include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal."); *Goodson v. Am. Bankers Ins. Co. of Fla.*, 295 S.C. 400, 403, 368 S.E.2d 687, 689 (Ct. App. 1988) ("Lack of familiarity with legal proceedings is unacceptable and the court will not hold a layman to any lesser standard than is applied to an attorney.").
