

Dear Mrs. Howard:

Barbara Chesley and I represent The Carolina Center for Behavioral Health in the above titled matter. According to our records, our office received the enclosed "Notice of Writ of Certiorari" from Ms. Walker on March 8, 2023, and "Notice of Appeal – Remittitur" from Ms. Walker on March 22, 2023. It does not appear that these documents were filed with the South Carolina Supreme Court. Ms. Walker appears to have filed other documents with the South Carolina Supreme Court, which the court received on March 21, 2023, but these filings have not been received by our office or our client.

By way of background, this matter was dismissed by the South Carolina Court of Appeals (Appellate Case No: 2022-001575) on November 22, 2022, and Remittitur was sent on February 2, 2023. See Wise v. S.C. Dept of Corr., 372 S.C. 173, 174, 642 S.E.2d 551, 551 (2007) ("When the remittitur has been properly sent, the appellate court no longer has jurisdiction over the matter and no motion can be heard thereafter."). We have included the documents we have received from Ms. Walker, the South Carolina Court of Appeals Order dismissing her appeal, and Remittitur with this letter.

As i mentioned in my first appeal i sent the appeal to the wrong courthouse and my appeal is 60 pages to 4 lawyers 240 pages plus the pages i sent the courthouse 300 pages and the 57 pages sent for SCDSS lawyer is 357 and sending a copy to him also would equal 414 pages in total and i am banned from ALL greenville libraries forever due to discrimination in me filing these lawsuits and do not have financial means to provide copies to all lawyers of clients because which is why i sent the notices so they can search the cases using their bar ID which all lawyers/ attorneys have access to search all documents filed for cases i do not have the finical means to provide copies to everyone since i am living off of \$51 weekly child support and is barley paying my monthly utility and phone bill along with toiletries and other household needs and things for my daughter as needed (and i am indigent) but i did send timely manner 3 notices of ALL appeals and changes to the cases to all 5 lawyers and updated all of them with the writ and the appeal and resent the appeal when i was notified that it was the wrong courthouse by the other Courthouse

The remitter was NOT properly sent they didn't allow the proper time to receive my response via mail which was sent and dated before the remitter they did not follow proper procedure ; This case should have never been Dismissed this was a example of judicial bias and judicial misconduct seeing i have a pending cases with the greenville county clerk (where i was assaulted by their officers and harassed 8/8/22) which they was aware of when the Dismissal of my cases decided this case should have never had to be sent through the court of appeals due to this being clear that my right to due process was waived and i was held against my will in this facility and they never gave me the "patient copy " nor let me meet my lawyer neither was i aware of the hearing being held in my absence my lawyer never met me either she confirmed when we talked on the phone for 30 mins after i looked her up online and filed my lawsuit the day after at greenville county clerk when i learned there was a actual hearing held without me knowing about it i was tormented and called racial slurs for and drugged for 33 days against my will when i was only suppose to be there 3 days after i got rest this was a racial hate crime due to the color of my skin since i was called racial slurs for 33 days this was intentional this was not accident because this incident has happened again on 8/10/22-8/22/22 where i was held against my will again by the state while attempting to recieve justice for the incident that ocured in 2020 with the carolina center for behavioral health due to the clients high profile and relationships with judges , hospitals , police and other personal realationships my cases is NOT receiving justice this is judicial bias and judicial misconduct this was a CLEAR example that my Constutional Right to due process was violated intentionally and without remorse (and i sent them a copy of this letter to lawyers due to it only being 1 page)

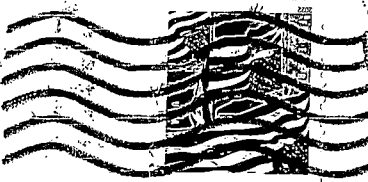
