Back to my 3/14/23 calls to the Court of Appeals to confirm if my appeal deadline was 3/15 or not. After telling me Shelby no longer works there, she said she was an appeal specialist and could help me. She said my deadline was 3/16, not 3/15, and that it was in the Court's system. I asked if it could be wrong, or changed at a later point in time, or if the Supreme Court might have 3/15 in their system instead. She said no to all 3 points, and said both courts share the same system and thus both have 3/16 as the deadline.

Just to make sure, I mailed it, making sure to get it postmarked 3/15, and then I also emailed it 3/16 to make sure the remittitur date didn't post while it was in transit.

The point would be moot except you haven't received the mail. I have no explanation. Maybe the mail might be misplaced within the Court's confines. Perhaps a search might uncover it?

It wouldn't be fair nor equitable to dismiss the case in this way. The Court should be held accountable for the breakdown of its system and its employees and for misleading me.
